

## **Second Annual Walk in the Park to benefit Riverside Bark Dog Park Fact Sheet**

**Date:** Sunday, June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2006 – RAIN OR SHINE

**Time:** Registration starts at 8:30 am, Walk from 9 – 10, contests & demonstrations after the walk

**Location:** Riverside Park in Raymond, NH – end of Sundeen Parkway off of Langford Road

**Purpose:** To raise remaining funds needed to complete the dog park – balance of fencing, rules signs, sponsor signs, benches, commemorative brick installation.

**Cost:** \$10 per dog registration fee, additional sponsor donations gladly accepted.

**Contests & Games include:** Best Owner/Dog Look-Alikes, Games of “Musical Sit”. Prizes will be awarded!

**Vendors/Demonstrators:** Welcome – cost for table space is \$25. Contact Raymond Animal Hospital at 895-3163 for more information. Vendor set-up is at 8 am, rain or shine. Vendors need to bring their own table & “protection” in the event of bad weather.

Bring registration sheet, registration fee and donations to the walk the day of the event. Checks made payable to “Raymond Recreation Department” and in the memo Portion “Riverside Bark – Dog Walk”. All walkers must sign a waiver. No walkers under the age of 18 without parental/guardian consent.

**Misc. Walk info:** Walkers should come prepared with Bug repellent and pets should have tick protection. DOGS MUST BE LEASHED AT ALL TIMES! As parts of the Park can be wet or muddy at this time of year, wear appropriate footwear. Baggies will be provided to all walkers for pet clean up.

**Riverside Bark Dog Park Background:** Riverside Bark Dog Park is a 2-acre dog park located within Riverside Park in Raymond. It will be available free of charge to any dog owner in the area looking for a place for their dog(s) to play and run free! Riverside Bark is a non-profit organization completely funded by dog owners and lovers. We are completely dependent on donations & fundraisers to raise the funds needed to completely fence in the dog park and have it ready to open by late Spring /early Summer 2006. Fencing is scheduled to be installed by the beginning of May, depending on Mother Nature’s cooperation.
